Madam/ Sir.		

I am directed to inform that a complaint has been received through the Chief Minister's Secretariat, alleging students applying for master's programs at a university who hold Bachelor's degrees from other universities are facing harassment and unnecessary bureaucratic hurdles.

The issue revolves around the university's requirement for an "Equivalence Certificate." The process is allegedly over-burdensome and creating significant difficulties for students. Specifically, two major issues have been highlighted:

- 1. Delay in Submitting Final Documents: The University is demanding a letter from the Registrar of the student's previous institution, stating that the final mark sheet isn't available yet. The complainant argues this demand is impractical and beyond the student's control.
- 2. Lack of Empathy: The overall process reflects a lack of empathy and a serious administrative disconnect, creating a demoralizing experience for students who are trying to pursue higher education.

I am directed to request you to look into the matter and inform this Department by the 12th September 2025 positively whether students in the university are facing similar or any other problems during their admission.

An Action Taken Report is required to be submitted to Chief Minister's Secretariat and may kindly be treated as VERY URGENT.
