- i. Five **Research Fellowship Awards** - for a maximum period of 5 years for pursuing research work for Ph.D.
- ii. Two **Research Grant Awards** - to undertake research and development projects for a period of 3 years.

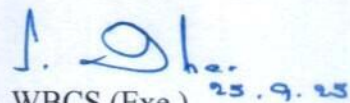
